
Great News!

I am delighted to inform you that we have just received confirmation that our bid for £10,000 from the Big Lottery Fund to develop the old KS1 playground in to a bright new outdoor learning area for use by our Ark Inclusion Team and the children of Years 1 and 2 has been successful. Most of the money will have to go on clearing and levelling the area; surfacing and making it safe and accessible. We will retain as many plants and trees as we can in the area and move those that cannot be used to other areas of school if we can. We will be looking at designs and hope to begin work later this summer.
